In each of their notes, the final entry, headed "disposal" listed a number of personal details including name, address and other release details.</p> <p>Suite extremely busy on arrival due to medical emergencies and difficult detainees. Additional custody staff brought in (arrived at 9pm). Multiple persons awaiting booking in – backlog was cleared as efficiently as possible. Some detainees felt they had been ignored during time in custody but issues were resolved by escorting officer during visit. Some detainees also praised quality of care.</p>

<p>Correct prints of custody logs were selected. This appears to be a 'glitch' in the I.T. system and will be passed on to IT/NICHE team to address.</p> <p>Post handover period there were already 3 detainees waiting.
