

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO 2014-009

Your request has now been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) and we provide our response below.

You asked:

- 1. How many members of staff did your office have when it was inherited from the Police Authority in November 2012, and what was the annual salary cost at that time?**
- 2. How many members of staff did your office have at March 31st, 2013, and what was the annual salary cost at that time?**
- 3. How many members of staff does your office have as of now, March 2014, and what is the current annual salary cost?**
- 4. Please state the job title and salary of each current member of staff, and state if their role was advertised or not?**
- 5. How many people does your office currently have working on a freelance / consultant / adviser basis and what is the cost of their contracts?**
- 6. How many people has your office seconded from local authorities / the police force and what is the cost of their salaries?**

Your request for information has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) and our response is as follows:

1. 5 members of staff plus part-time Treasurer services purchased from Dorset County Council. Salary cost £237,900.
2. 7 members of staff plus part-time Treasurer services purchased from Dorset County Council. Salary cost £317,300.
3. 9 members of staff plus part-time Treasurer services purchased from Dorset County Council. Salary cost £350,600

The Commissioning & Partnership Manager; Staff Officer & Data Analyst; Personal Assistant to the PCC; and Executive Support Officer transferred over from the Police Authority to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) in November 2012. All other posts were advertised.

NB: The previous Chief Executive also transferred across from the Police Authority to the OPCC but subsequently retired. The current Chief Executive was therefore appointed following a formal recruitment process which was advertised.
