Thanks for your email and apologies if our original FOI response was not particularly clear. However we would disagree with your assessment that we have no services for stalking victims for the following reasons:

 We commission Victim Support to provide support services for victims of crime, which will include non-domestic abuse victims of stalking and harassment. Funding for Victim Support over the financial years requested was:

2015/16 - £438,466 2016/17 - £438,466 2017/18 - £438,466

• We have also funded the Victims Bureau, part of the Victims Hub with Victim Support, as follows:

2015/16 - £230,800 2016/17 - £129,430 2017/18 - £127,762
