12-Dec-17	Extension of contract	The PCC signed an agreement to extend the 'Access for All' agreement with Police ICT Company for a further two years.	
11-Dec-17	Alliance Youth Teams	The PCC agreed to fund a joint campaign with D&C OPCC and the Alliance Youth Teams on Sexting.	
04-Dec-17	Community Capacity Building Worker	The PCC agreed to increase the funding for this role for a further year and to increase the contribution to £5.6 enabling an increase in working hours from 15 to 25 and provides a 2 year contract.

30-Oct-17	High Intensity Network	The PCC agreed to finance £35k to fund one full time Police Officer into a Dorset based High Intensity Network for one year.
