#### SUBJECT DATA ACCESS REQUEST

The attached form is intended to help you to request access to any of your personal information that may be held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Dorset.

This type of request is known as a Subject Access Request, and we are required to respond to such requests within a 30 day period.

### **Subject Access Rights**

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) provides individuals with the right to access their personal data. If you wish to exercise this right; complete the attached form carefully and return it to the address provided below.

Please note that the GDPR provides safeguards to any information that might be held on other individuals and so we are unlikely to disclose the personal information of other individuals in response to a subject access request from you.

#### Proof of Identity

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner needs to be satisfied that you are who you say you are. Consequently we ask you to provide evidence of your identity and address by supplying copies of at least two official documents which between them provide sufficient information to prove your name, data of birth, current address and signature, eg. birth/adoption certificate, driving licence, passport, medical card, utility bill or bank statement.

Please do not send original identity documents to us by post.
